Your child will be taking a medication that requires special monitoring. Because of the documentation required, your child will have to follow specific guidelines for medication refills.

- 1. Your child must have had a well child check up within the past year. We will be happy to schedule that appointment for you if necessary, but no controlled substances will be refilled unless your child has a current check up.
- 2. Appointments for medication refills WILL NOT be combined with visits for other illnesses, or with well check ups.
- 3. Your child will be seen in one month or sooner if there are any changes to their medication doses. "Three month " medication appointments will be made once there is documented stability on the current dose. This means that after a medication change your child will have to be seen again in 1 month before they can receive 3 months prescriptions.
- 4. If you cannot make your appointment, please call to Reschedule. Repeated "no-shows" will result in your having to obtain care for your child with another provider.
- 5. An adult will be required to sign for all prescriptions. NO REPLACEMENTS WILL BE GIVEN FOR LOST PRESCRIPTIONS SO PLEASE TAKE THEM TO YOUR PHARMACY.
- 6. Referrals for counseling will be for 3 visits to see if it is a "good fit". You may need to be seen for year long referral after that time.

We understand that it is difficult to manage frequent appointments, however, in prescribing controlled substances there are guidelines that we must follow. Thank you for your understanding.
